Malaco Leichhardt Pty Ltd

Malaco Leichhardt Pty Ltd produces copper cathodes from the Mount Cuthbert site approximately 100km NE of Mount Isa in Queensland. Following a period of recommissioning, the first copper cathodes were produced on site in February 2014.

Copper ore is currently being sourced from the Mount Watson pit, which is 30km north of the Mount Cuthbert processing plant, which includes a heap leach, solvent extraction and electrowinning facility.

The project covers a large area with numerous tenements. There is currently exploration being conducted to identify additional resources of copper ores.

MABOR Cupels and Bullion Blocks

At the start of February Rowe Scientific acquired the assets of Assay Supplies of Australia, giving us direct access to the "Mabor" range of cupels and bullion blocks.

The most accurate method of gold analysis (eg for Stock Exchange reporting) uses a process

known as Fire Assay. Its origins can be traced back to the Romans who experimented with purifying gold 2000 years ago. Fire Assay can be used to measure gold both in ores and for determination of purity in gold bars (bullion).


In ores, after a process called "fusion", a lead button is produced which contains many of the precious metals – gold, silver, platinum etc. "Cupellation" is the process of separating the lead to leave the precious metals behind.

A cupel can be made of magnesium oxide (from a mineral called magnesite) or calcium phosphate (bone ash). The lead button is placed on the cupel and heated at ~900 degrees C in an air draft. The resulting lead oxide is absorbed by the cupel leaving behind a tiny bead containing the precious metals. A common method for determining the concentration of gold is then to analyse by AAS. Thus the concentration of gold in the ore sample can be determined.

Mabor cupels have been made in India since 1899 by the Raju family. Their processes are supported by ISO 9001 accreditation.

Their constant refinement and development of the cupel and bullion blocks delivers a quality product that Rowe Scientific are proud to be associated with.
